The Haida Gwaii Child Care Resource & Referral program provides support, resources and referral services for child care providers, parents and caregivers in all communities on Haida Gwaii. We partner with community groups to provide workshops, training and professional development opportunities. We aim to promote quality childcare choices that meet the needs of local families. We are part of the Islands Wellness Society, an inclusive community-based agency that provides a variety of services in a safe and supportive environment. Salary will be commensurate with experience.

The CCRR program is currently seeking to bring another person into both the agency and CCRR on a part time basis. The successful candidate will be a self-motivated and organized person who works well with others and with the public.
