Gwaii Trust responds to continuing emergency situation

The COVID-19 Emergency Response Grant, designed to help keep islanders safe, healthy, fed, sheltered and connected, continues to fund a variety of pandemic responses. As of mid-August, we have distributed \$688,000 to local governments and local non-profit organizations, who have leveraged an additional \$354,000 in other funding. Recently-funded projects include Meals on Wheels in Sandspit, tech supplies for students at Chief Matthews School, personal protective equipment for firefighters in Skidegate, a community garden in Masset, meal delivery for seniors and shut-ins in Port Clements, and an initiative to bring fresh halibut to islanders.

The Emergency Response Grant continues to be open to applications from local non-profits and local governments. No equity is required, and projects may be in progress. We review applications and make decisions within about one week. Visit our website at gwaiitrust. com for complete details about this grant and how to apply.

Money is available for youth initiatives

The Youth Grant provides funding to organizations and local governments on Haida Gwaii for educational and recreational services aimed at youth. We have money available for projects that support increased opportunities for youth in sports, culture, arts and outdoor activities.
