2021 Annual General Meeting Highlights

On May 14 the Gwaii Trust held its first in-person annual general meeting in two years in the beautiful village of Daajing Giids, as well as making it available online for those unable to attend.

During the meeting we presented our 2021 financial statements and shared some highlights from the past year, including:

- 567 grants, totaling \$2.14 million
- \$120,000 for Haida language programs
- \$286,500 for Food Security and Food Sovereignty programs

- \$378,000 in Continuing Education grants
- \$400,000 in Major Contributions grants
- \$149,000 in Community Innovation grants

We also said goodbye to Chair James Cowpar who has been at the helm of the Gwaii Trust Board since 2016, and welcomed Huu<u>x</u> *Percy Crosby* for a three-year term.
